Main Responsibilities and key tasks/job description

This is an exciting opportunity to join Albany Pet Services in the role of Dog walker and pet sitter. The dog walker and pet sitter will have regular dogs that they will build a relationship with and walk and check in on a regular basis. They will also go into client's homes and care for cats and small animals while their guardians are away on holiday. The dog walker and pet sitter will be a caring, communicative person who cares for pets as if they were their own. They will have an excellent interest and understanding of pets and their body language. We are a young, vibrant company with a can do attitude. This is an exciting time to join us.

The role includes:

- Attend consultations and meet with the pet and their guardian and ask questions and communicate guidelines and protocol for care.

- Carrying out the task and spot checking the area for any thing the animal may eat or hurt themselves on and raising any concerns to management such as sickness, illness and acting appropriately if needed such as taking the pet to the vet.
- Prepare food and water for the pet and give medication if required
- Attend to the individual needs of the pets – if they're muddy then clean them.
- If reinforcing training then monitor training and make notes and report back to guardian and management.
- Complete documentation on the database regarding animals.
- Clean out and scoop litter trays and food and water bowls.
- Ensure gardens are secure and doors are locked at the end of a visit.
- Communicate with clients about their pet and how their walk/or visit went.
- Logging on to visits via the pet sitting portal
- Attend to the questions of clients and if not sure to research and enquire.

Skills and Experience required

We are looking for someone who not only loves animals and cares for their wellbeing but who is genuinely interested in them. We would like people with experience in working with animals before. Excellent interpersonal skills, including listening and communication, tact, diplomacy, sensitivity and patience are essential qualities for fulfilling this position.
